Just got home from distributing backpacks to 60 kids - 140 more to go! Why do I do this? So they will know Jesus, His love and have an education. One day, I believe some of these kids will be leaders who love God and walk in His ways - world changers!

Costco was not able to give us backpacks this year and neither was the Fundacion. Decisions, decisions. I finally ordered 120 empty backpacks and with those that were donated by several churches in San Diego we were able to provide 275 filled backpacks for underprivileged children -

good job church! These kids could not otherwise afford school supplies and many drop out of school for this reason. Thirty-six kids also received full sponsorship with uniforms and shoes.

WE are making a difference - you and us together - obeying and serving and filling with His love.

Some of you know that we opened a breakfast kitchen about 6 weeks ago at our church. The children were hungry, the Lord provided us with a kitchen and people in the congregation had a heart to serve. It is beautiful to see how this has pulled the congregation together





and friendships are developing. Over 30 kids a day are receiving breakfast and we will soon change to lunch when school starts. Can you imagine going to school with hunger pains? Or drinking water brought by a tank truck. These are realities for the kids we work with. If you would like to partner with us on the purchase of food, please let me know. Where will they be without Jesus? The majority look forward to graduating from 6th grade or Jr. high and then working, having babies, etc. (out of marriage). The girl's 15th birthday celebration is an announcement to the world that she is available. A few weeks ago about 40 young gangster types were dancing in the street and blasting a song in English while a young girl practiced for her quinceanera (15th), during our Thursday bible study. I could see the eyes of the young ones on her sexy dance and realized that this is all many look forward to. Then life moves on as an adult with no money, no skills, lots of kids and changing partners often. How sad that they do not know how much more God has for them.

Jesus can! By the power of His word we can see change! Help us to stand firm and declare His truth. Pray for us! Donate to the feeding kitchen program. Pray about supporting this ministry on a monthly basis - there are many new costs with this church plant. We live by faith in the one who died for us. Nothing else matters.

The boys are great - challenging sometimes but that's how parenting is. The congregation is slowly growing but we need more men. The women's bible study is lead by Marina and the Holy Spirit is moving and healing and bringing unity. The youth group needs prayer for growth.

As summer ends, I am tired. Why? Because we had many awesome teams! The Tijuana School Program was blessed again. The orphanages received the grant to pay for their schooling. The ministry is exciting. YUGO sent their summer interns to hold a 3 day vacation bible school at Vista del Valle. By the third day there were 80 kids and all had breakfast too! But, many of you will be pleased to hear that I went to a one day retreat where I filled myself with Jesus!

I love God, my family and all of you who faithfully pray and support this ministry. We pray for you. We think about you.
