## PESINA PRINTS AUGUST NEWSLETTER 2014

We are excited to share some news with you! As you know, during the past few years, my responsibilities and ministry with YUGO Ministries have moved from "Mercy Ministries Coordinator" to "Church Planter" with my husband, Jose Luis Pesina. I actually did not change my vision or even type of ministry, but rather than working with many small churches and orphanages, we have been focusing on the community of Vista del Valle and the surrounding area for 3.5 years through our Calvary Chapel church plant, Gracia del Calvario. Our vision is still raising godly leaders, discipleship and training, evangelism and mercy ministries, which includes the school program, lunch programs and medical ministry.

YUGO actually does not plant churches as part of their ministry but several YUGO missionaries have married Mexican pastors. YUGO has been wonderful in finding a niche for us within their organization and we are happy to say that I have been serving with YUGO for more than seven years and I am continuing with YUGO Ministries as a "church planter"!

The Lord has provided for the ministry in many ways including partnerships with other existing ministries in Mexico who have the same heart to see community transformation in the area we serve. Through these relationships, the Lord showed us that it is His desire that we form a 501(c)(3) corporation in the USA to allow for Gracia del Calvario church to have a long term vehicle to receive tax deductible support and to allow us to fund ministries that don't otherwise fall under the vision of YUGO. The name of our new 501(c)(3) corporation is "Grace of Calvary Ministries". I will continue to be under the spiritual guidance of the leaders at YUGO who have been so helpful to us.

All of my personal ministry support will continue to be sent to YUGO Ministries at P. O. Box 58, National City, CA. Our personal support is used to fund the nuts and bolts of the ministry such as car/travel expenses, all office expenses, internet, visas, education and training, and a minimum wage draw for our family to live on. We are so grateful for our monthly supporters that have the confidence in us and faith in God to provide for these expenses so that we can continue to serve in the calling that the Lord has given us.

Gracia del Calvario is directly accountable to the Calvary Chapel leaders in Baja California, specifically, Jonathan Domingo, pastor of Horizonte in Ensenada. As well, Jose Luis voluntarily reports to Pastor Mike Vincent, Jesus Ochoa and Fernando Serrano as mentors. We also attend Calvary Chapel Rosarito on Sundays to worship the Lord and receive the Word of God so that we are not spiritually drained as we go out to pastor Gracia del Calvario Vista del Valle. My USA home church, North Coast Calvary Chapel is also a great blessing to us.

If you have any questions, we are happy to meet with you and discuss this. The leadership at YUGO has been part of the decision since day one and this in no way changes my relationship with YUGO Ministries.
