

PESINA PRINTS GRACIA DEL CALVARIO CHURCH OCTOBER 2014


Consider the lilies, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin; and yet I say to you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. ²⁸... ²⁹“And do not seek what you should eat or what you should drink, nor have an anxious mind. ... ³¹But seek the kingdom of God, and all these things shall be added to you. Luke 12.

The most amazing thing we see is God preparing the way ahead of us. Miracles happening before we even knew we needed a miracle. Example #1: Baby Samuel needed a tiny house to recover from the removal of his eye and cancerous tumor. Before I shared the need with my friends, someone had already donated money for an “extra house”! Four days later that house was built for Sammy and he is recovering well. He does not need chemotherapy but will require an artificial eye that costs \$450 each time he grows. That is two months wages for his parents. (Photos is before surgery)



Example #2: I asked the leaders of Antorchista to loan us a lot to open a second lunch kitchen for the school kids. Many kids go to school with no breakfast and there is little or no lunch when they get home. On the way to the meeting I received a phone call that provision had been sent to start the lunch kitchen. We now have a large lot and will be serving hot lunches, prepared by Outside the Bowl, under pop-up shade tents on paper bowls starting next week. The ministry will be run by the women from our church who live in that section. Please pray for a trailer or portable structure where the kids can eat lunch and our supplies will be safe. I’m sure God already has this one figured out too!

Praises for our first all-church baptism and bar-b-q at Los Alisos swimming pools in Tecate. Eleven people were baptized and 160 attended the event hosted by Life Mission Church from Escondido. We were also blessed with beautiful hard cover, large print bibles to use during our services. It was a beautiful time of families and the body of Christ playing and breaking bread together.



Welcome to Miguel Garcia as part-time staff. He is working with Jose Luis three days a week as his assistant in handling the church, staff and construction. With a growing congregation, Miguel is a necessary blessing and we have already seen the men’s ministry increase with his help. His wage is \$20 per day if you would like to help sponsor Miguel.

Building Update: latest word is that the upper building might be built at the end of March. This means we will meet in the “garage” and tents for the winter. There is still plenty of concrete work to be done before the upper level can be constructed but the construction fund balance is low. Gifts can be sent to Grace of Calvary Ministries.

We have seen many new families join us who want to know Jesus. One man said “this church teaches the heart, not just the head”. People are starting to serve and love on their neighbors. Kids are getting fed spiritually and physically. We are encouraged by God and by our partners in ministry. We need you and we are thankful for you. We are not anxious about finances but we are standing on God’s promise to “seek the kingdom of God, and all these things shall be added to you.”
